Title of Paper: Nottingham Together, EU EXIT and Cohesion Update

Date: 8th September 2017

1. Purpose

This paper is provided as a background to the regular Board updates on Community Cohesion and the EU Referendum result. It also includes some background information on Nottingham Together, on which there will be a presentation.

2. Recommendation


Members are asked to comment on the local implications and impact of the EU Exit and progress of the Bill through Parliament, the Nottingham Together programme and cohesion.

3. Background

- 3.1 At each ON Board meeting there is a short agenda item in which members have been able to consider and offer implications and impacts of the EU referendum result. The meetings have attempted to keep a view of the implications on the EU referendum result, providing a local angle when it has been possible. The purpose of this discussion is to understand the local position within the national context.
- 3.2 Meetings have also received a verbal update on cohesion, potentially related hate crime reports and locally organised initiatives and publications.
